Eligibility

- Seeding in the draws is based on the latest Canadian ratings available at the time of the draw.

- The Tournament Committee may estimate the rating of any unrated player at any time during the tournament and remove that player from any event for which such a rating would make the player ineligible.

Format:

- All single events shall have preliminary round robins followed by single knockouts, All individual matches are best of 5 games to 11 points.
- ***Handicap Singles** event will be run on a points handicap system. High ranking players will have a large points handicap, lower ranking players will have a low points handicap or possibly none. **This event is open to all players.**

Rules

- Current ITTF Laws and Regulations will be in effect.
- All rackets must be black on one side and red on the other, with ITTF approved coverings.
- Players arriving to the table later than 5 mins after their match is called may be defaulted.
- Use of Speed Glue/Booster will not be permitted in accordance to ITTF regulation.
- Tracksuit or any part thereof and street clothes cannot be worn during play except by special permission of the Referee. **Shorts and short sleeved/sleeveless playing shirt MUST be worn during match. Colour of playing shirt should NOT be WHITE and BRIGHT YELLOW, playing shoes must be non-marking.**
- Events with fewer than 6 entries may be cancelled or combined with another event, and the cash prize (if any) of that event may be adjusted at the discretion of the Tournament Committee.
- The Tournament Committee reserves the right to cancel any event due to insufficient entries.
- Unpaid entries at the time of the Draw will **NOT** be included in the tournament.

Umpiring

- Players will be asked to umpire some matches they do not play in within their own R/R groups.
- Players after losing a knock-out match should expect to be called to umpire one match afterwards
- Players may have to umpire their own matches if this is not possible.

An effort will be made to provide umpires for semi finals onwards
